


GLASS FAMILY

A fictional family in New York, appearing in several J. D. Salinger's short stories (*Nine Stories; Raise High the Roof Beam, Carpenters and Seymour: An Introduction; Franny and Zooey*).

LES GLASS
A retired vaudeville performer, he is Australian and Jewish and is in the entertainment business. He is criticized by Seymour in *Hapworth 16, 1924*.

BESSIE

Bessie is a retired vaudeville performer. She is Irish and is constantly worried about the fact that her children are talented, yet unable to fit into society.



SEYMOUR GLASS

The eldest, Seymour is featured in *Raise High the Roof Beam, Carpenters and Seymour: An Introduction* and *Franny and Zooey*. He is the main character in *A Perfect Day for Bananafish*. Seymour was a brilliant intellectual, and became a professor at Columbia at 20.

WEBB GALLAGHER "BUDDY" GLASS

The narrator of *Franny and Zooey* and protagonist in *Raise High the Roof Beam, Carpenters and Seymour: An Introduction*. Buddy is often considered to be Salinger's alter ego. He lives in upstate New York and teaches English at a rural women's college. Buddy and Seymour were born only two years apart, spent most of their youths living together, and were very close

BEATRICE "BOO BOO"

Married, mother of three children, appears in *Down at the Dinghy*, is mentioned in *Hapworth 16, 1924*, and is often referenced in *Raise High the Roof Beam, Carpenters*. She modestly prefers to be referred to as a "Tuckahoe homemaker."

WALTER F. "WALT" GLASS

The twin brother of Waker Glass. He was an American soldier who died in Occupied Japan when a stove he was packaging exploded. He was described in *Franny and Zooey* as being the only truly lighthearted son in the family.

WAKER

The twin brother of Walter Glass. A Roman Catholic monk of the Carthusian order. Little is known about Waker, because none of the stories have been written specifically about him.

ZACHARY MARTIN

He is an actor, and (according to himself) the most attractive of all the children. He also says that he and Buddy were "too clever" for their own good. He is portrayed as being rather arrogant and particularly insensitive to his mother, Bessie, frequently swearing at her and calling her "fatty."

FRANCES "FRANNY" GLASS

She is a twenty-year-old college student and actress. In *Franny and Zooey*, she is reading *The Way of a Pilgrim*, an anonymous Orthodox Christian classic, which contributes to her spiritual and emotional breakdown.

All the children appeared on fictional radio quiz show "It's a Wise Child", which sent all seven Glass children through college.

OBITELJ GLASS

Izmišljena obitelj koja živi u New Yorku i koja se pojavljuje u nekoliko kratkih priča J. D. Salingera (*Devet priča; Visoko podignite krovnu gredu, tesari i Seymour: uvod; Franny i Zooey*).

LES GLASS

Umirovljeni izvodač u vodvilju Australac je i židov te se bavi industrijom zabave. Seymour ga kritizira u kratkoj priči *Hapworth 16, 1924*.

BESSIE GLASS

Umirovljena izvođačica u vodvilju Irkinja je koja je neprestano zabrinuta zbog činjenice da su njezina djeca darovita, a ne mogu se uklopiti u društvo.

SEYMOUR GLASS

Najstarije dijete u obitelji, Seymour, može se naći u djelima *Visoko podignite krovnu gredu, tesari i Seymour: uvod te Franny i Zooey*. Seymour je glavni lik kratke priče *Perfektan dan za banana-ribe*. Bio je briljantan intelektualac te je postao profesor na Sveučilištu Columbia u dobi od dvadeset godina.

WEBB GALLAGHER "BUDDY" GLASS

Pripovjedač u djelu *Franny and Zooey* i protagonist u knjizi *Visoko podignite krovnu gredu, tesari i Seymour: uvod*. Buddija se često smatra Salingerovim alter egom. On živi u sjevernom dijelu države New York i predaje engleski na ruralnom ženskom koledžu. Buddy i Seymour rođeni su u razmaku od samo dvije godine, proveli su većinu svoje mladosti živeći zajedno i bili su vrlo bliski.

GLASS TANNENBAUM

Udana je, majka troje djece, pojavljuje se u kratkoj priči *Dolje kod čamca*, spominje se u kratkoj priči *Hapworth 16, 1924*, a često i u knjizi *Visoko podignite krovnu gredu, tesari*. U svojem skromnom stilu, radije želi da je nazivaju "domaćicom iz Tuckahoea."

WALTER F. "WALT" GLASS

Brat je blizanac Wakera Glassa. Bio je američki vojnik koji je poginuo u okupiranom Japanu kada je eksplodirala peć koju je pakirao. U djelu *Franny i Zooey* opisan je kao jedini sin u obitelji koji je istinski vedar.

GLASS

Brat je blizanac Waltera Glassa. Rimokatolički je redovnik Kartuzijanskog reda. O Wakeru se zna malo jer niti jedna priča nije napisana baš o njemu.

ZACHARY MARTIN "ZOOEY" GLASS

On je glumac i (po vlastitom mišljenju) najzgodniji od sve djece. Također kaže da su on i Buddy "prepametni" za svoje vlastito dobro. Opisan je kao ohol i bezosjećajan prema svojoj majci, Bessie, često je nazivajući "masnom" i drugim pogrdnim riječima.

FRANCES "FRANNY" GLASS

Ona je dvadesetogodišnja studentica i glumica. U djelu *Franny i Zooey*, ona čita *Put jednog hodočasnika*, anonimni pravoslavni klasik, što pridonosi njezinom duhovnom i emocionalnom slomu.

Sva djeca gostovala su na izmišljenom radio kvizu "It's a Wise Child", što je svoj sedmorici omogućilo studij.
